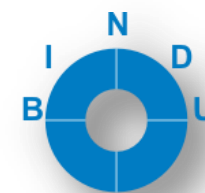

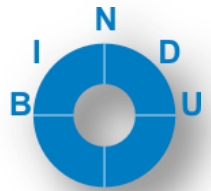

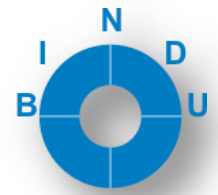
# **BINDU**

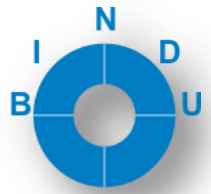

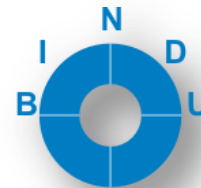

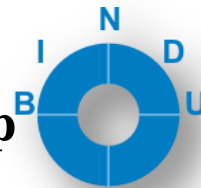

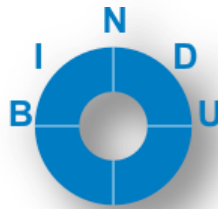

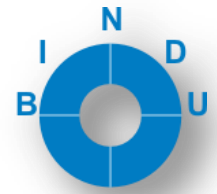

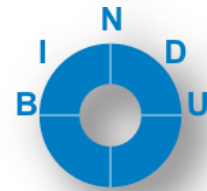

BINDU collated large historical and pre-existing data on communities and disasters that shook the state of Uttarakhand under the project. All 13 districts of Uttarakhand were covered by BINDU under this process.

This assignment was primary based on the secondary data set. The data tables concerning socio economic profiles, disaster exposure, relief, recovery, compensation, rehabilitation and vulnerability were compiled and analyzed to make risks assessments and captures the vulnerability of the communities.

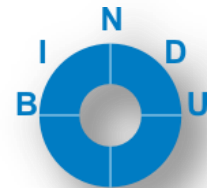

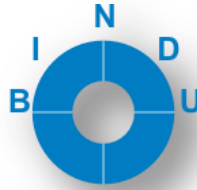




## **Future Plan -2020-21**
